

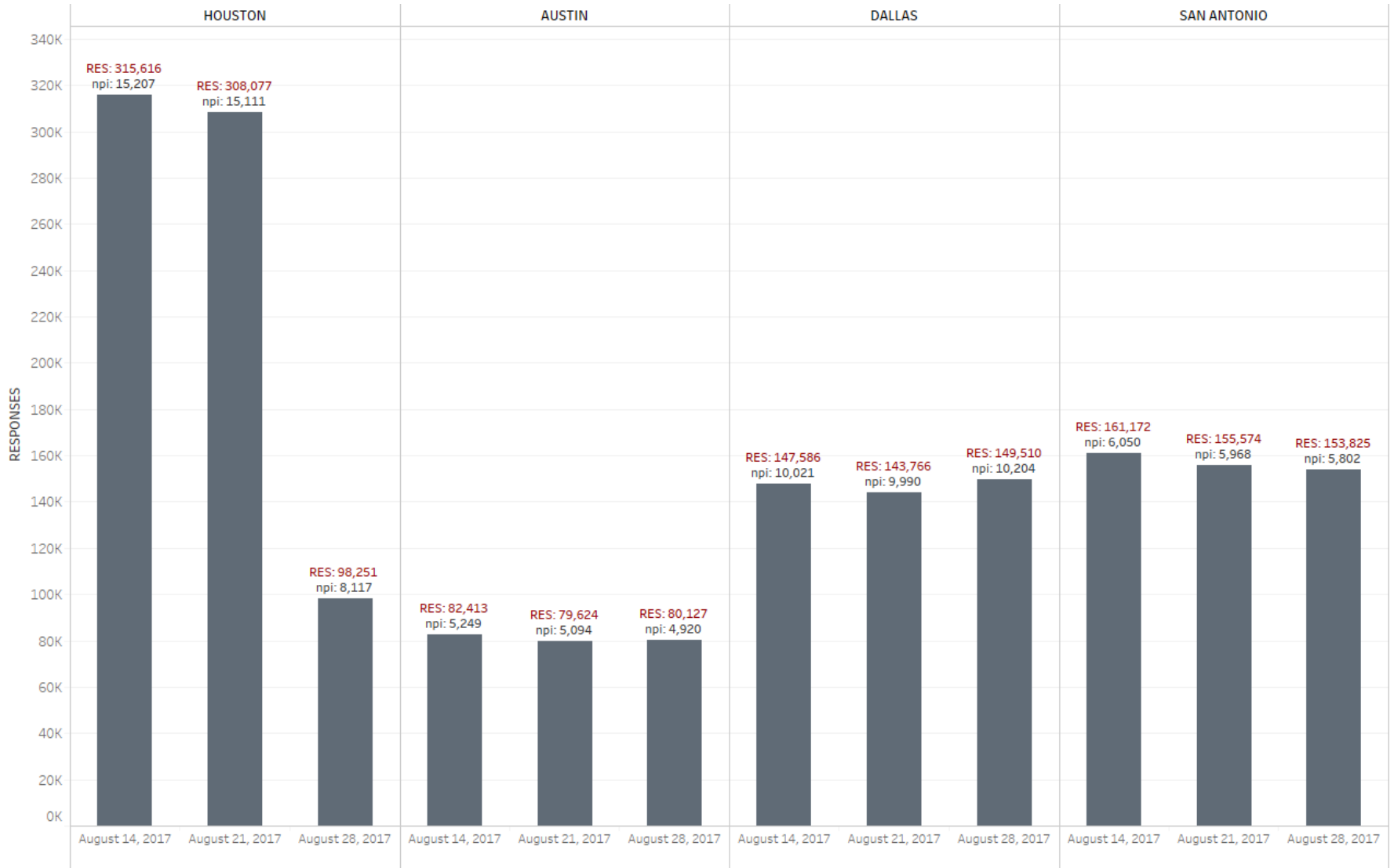
HURRICANE HARVEY: DATA TRENDS

AS OF AUGUST 28, 2017

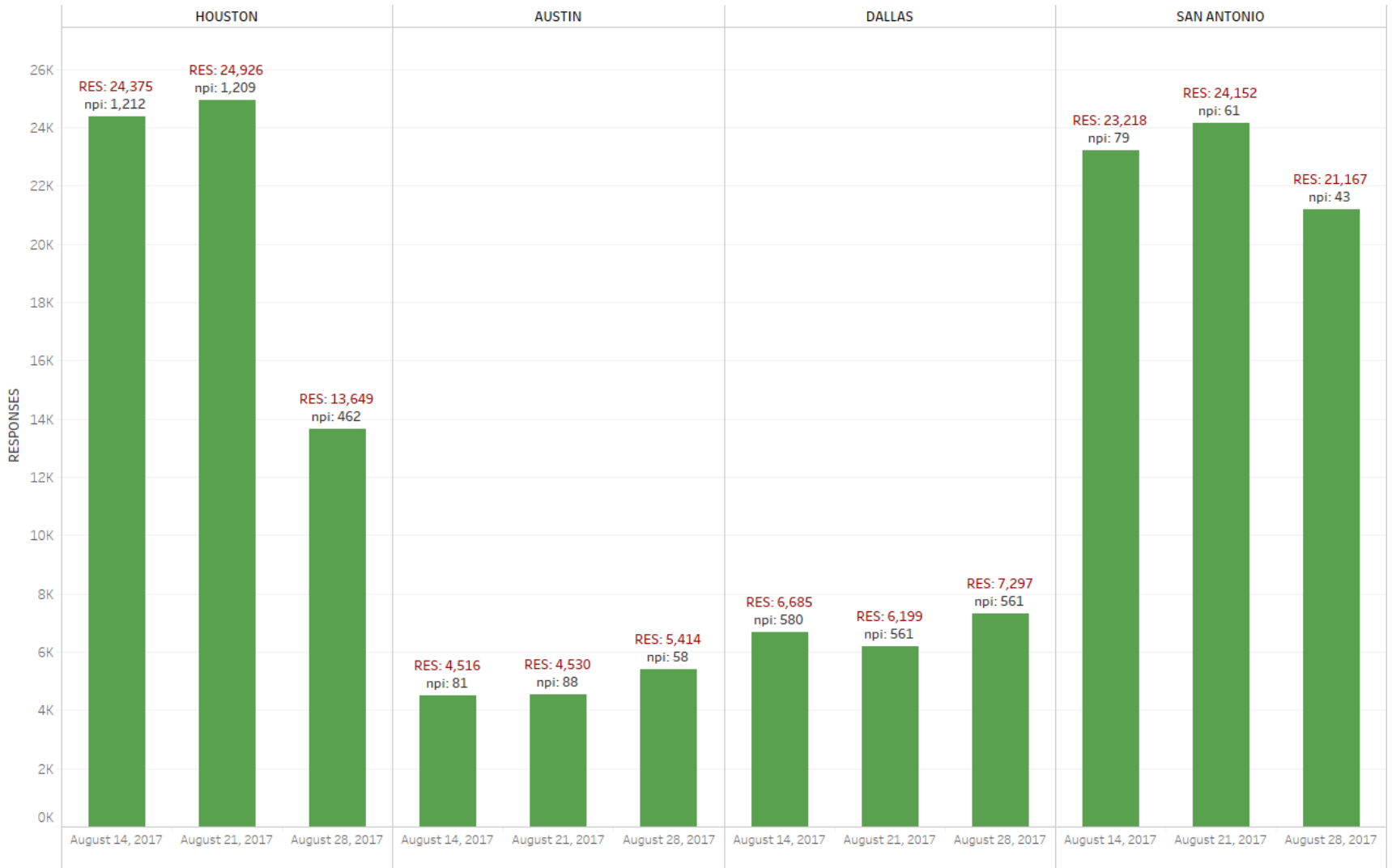
KEY FINDINGS

- There was a significant decline in Medication History Ambulatory transactions in Houston when Harvey hit, going from 300,000+ transactions on a typical Monday to 98,000 on August 28; No significant change was observed in Austin, Dallas and San Antonio as of August 28.
- There was a less significant decline in Medication History for Reconciliation transactions in Houston when Harvey hit, going from 24,000+ transactions on a typical Monday to 13,000 on August 28; There was a slight increase in Austin and Dallas, but not in San Antonio during the same time period.
- There was a huge decline in new electronic prescriptions in Houston when Harvey hit, going from 52,000 NewRx transactions on a typical Monday to 3,500 on August 28; There was no significant change in Austin, Dallas and San Antonio.

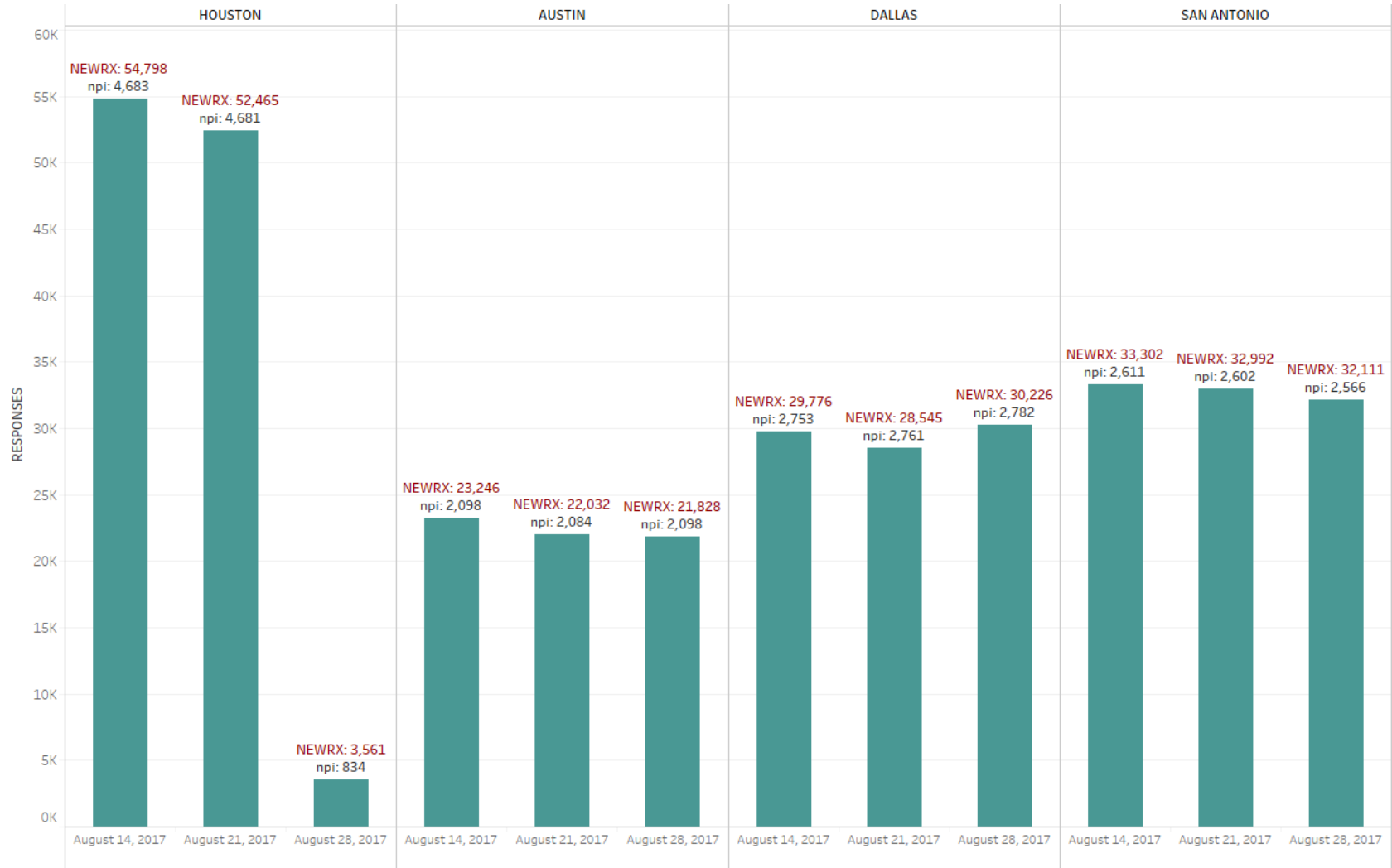
Medication History Ambulatory
